Conditions of entry and entry forms have been emailed and will also be available at the Studio. Please spread the word about this Sale amongst your networks—it would be lovely to see even greater patronage than for previous sales! Some of the conditions of entry are:

- ◆ Entrants must be financial members of the HDGA & are expected to assist with setting up and/or running the show
- ◆ TWO copies of the completed entry form and the \$25.00 entry fee must accompany entries
- ◆ Your folio can contain a maximum of 25 works and one A1 size framed work may be hung (if enough space)
- ◆ Pricing of your work must be \$10.00 OR MORE. Your name, work title, price and corresponding number from the entry form must be on the back of each work and on the front of hanged work

It would also be great to have some artists doing some live painting work outside Richard Randall studio over the two days. Please contact Ruth (Secretary) if you are interested in participating in this activity.

- ◆ And to all who have been participating in the Cleaning Roster : THANK YOU and keep up the great work. Your efforts are very much appreciated.

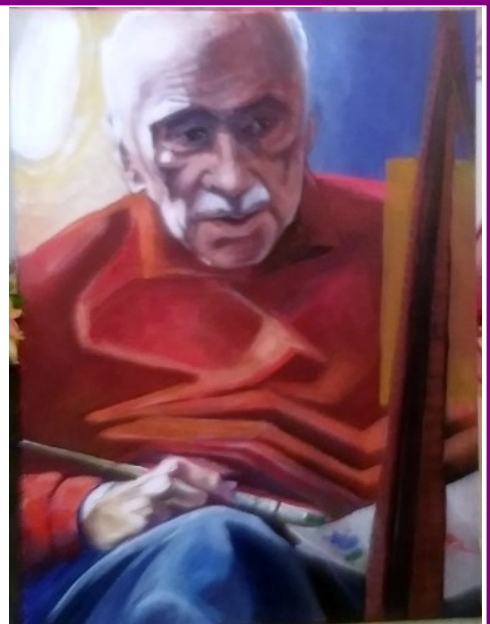
Workshop News

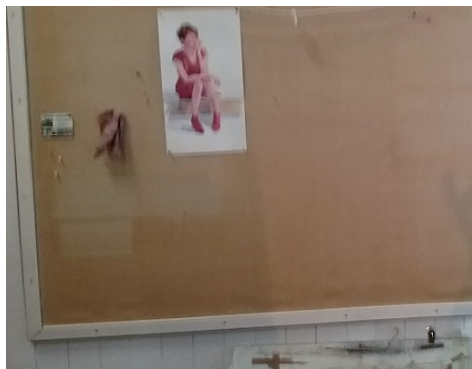
