An opened umbrella sat slightly behind her and a contrasting carry bag (belonging to someone there on the day) was placed in front of the umbrella.

In 2012, Jack and his wife Una were jointly awarded the Dr Irene Amos Book award, for their services to the HDGA.


Jack's long life saw him earn 3 University degrees, work for the Commonwealth Bank, be a corporal during the war and practice law until his retirement in 1994.

In the visual arts he studied at the Brisbane Technical College with Roy Churcher, wood-carving with Elwyn Harvery and pottery with Kitty Dick.

After retirement, Jack devoted more time to his membership of the RQAS, the Water Colour Society and then, later, the HDGA. It was only in recent months that he was unable to attend the HDGA Monday workshops. He has been, and will continue to be, greatly missed.

Jack exhibited with the HDGA as recently as the 2016 Annual Exhibition. Photos, below:




