<u>NUTTER BUZACOTI</u>



Nutter "Buz" Buzacott was a printmaker, commercial artist (graphic designer), political illustrator, painter and teacher.

Born in Perth he travelled widely in Australia and Europe and came to Queensland late in his career.

In Melbourne he attended Wesley College, where he was a champion athlete. He attended a commercial art college (Cyril Leyshon White) and left Melbourne to study commercial art in Sydney (1924-26), working at Farmers in the day and studying at Julian Ashton's Sydney Art School at night.

"Buz" was a member and Vice President of the HDGA in 1962.




